Last Thursday, January 14, one of our staff members tested positive during our all-staff COVID testing. Unfortunately, that put us in another outbreak status per the DHSS, which will require repeated testing for our Residents over the next few weeks. We immediately tested all Residents on Friday, January 15, and all were negative at that time, thanks be to God. However, yesterday on January 18, another staff member tested positive. Both staff members are recovering at home and we hold them and their families in our prayers.

We continue to monitor our Residents for any symptoms and we will test them again on Friday along with more staff testing. Family members whose loved ones had direct exposure to the staff members have been notified and their loved ones are in isolation for 14 days as an added precaution. We have four Residents in precautionary isolation and they are all doing fine so far.

Our work is not over with this virus and yet we call on our beloved St Joseph to continue providing us with confident determination, guidance and loving protection. We remember you in our prayers, and we ask your prayers for us, all the Residents, and our staff.
