We are immediately taking precautions to minimize exposure to other residents. We are continuing to test staff as well. Again, I ask if you do not need to visit, please hold off until we stabilize this situation. Thank you for your cooperation and prayers.

AM Update

Dear Family and Friends,

This morning one of our residents tested positive on the third floor. The family has been notified. We are immediately preceding to test all residents today. We will update you again once we have completed this round of testing.

While CDC guidance does not restrict visitation, we ask for your safety and that of our residents and staff, that your visitation be limited to essential visits and that all proper distancing, handwashing and a surgical mask or KN95 be worn at all times.

Given the high positivity and high transmission rate (37.36%) in the county at this time, we are anticipating that this new positive case in our Home, along with recent positive staff, will not be the end of this surge in the short term.

We are blessed to have plenty of testing and PPE supplies in our Home. We rely on you for your prayers and support. And, we rely mostly on our staff to persist in their care for our residents.
