Dear Families,

Since my letter to you last week, we have made significant progress in suppressing the spread of COVID-19 in our Home. Unfortunately, we still have two residents that tested positive Monday and Tuesday this week, and their families were notified. One is on the 2nd floor and one on the 3rd floor. Likewise, spread among the staff is down to just one this week and we continue to test staff and residents on-going throughout the week.

Of the nine positive residents from last week, six of them are out of isolation and doing fine. The other three will be out of isolation tomorrow, Aug 12, and they too are doing well.

Per updated guidance, visitation and outings are allowed in the Home to residents who are not in quarantine. Visitors must wear masks (over the nose) at all times and go directly to the resident's room. Please be mindful to social distance from others when passing through the building and use proper hand hygiene.

We are continuing on-going rounds of testing with all residents and staff as directed per CMS guidance and will notify you if additional positive cases occur.

Please pray for all of us, and especially pray for our staff whom we depend on so much.
